EXECUTIVE ORDER #183

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Lawrence W. "Larry" Millard of the Endeavor Moundville Fire Department

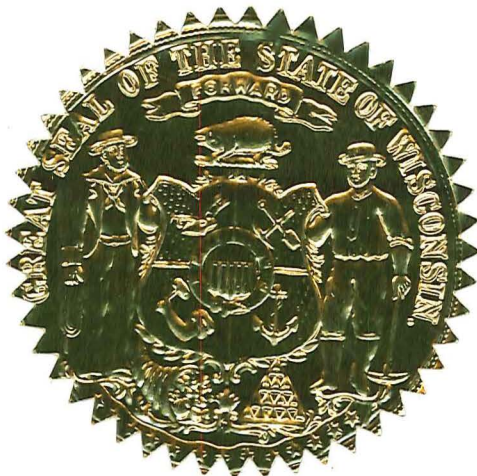
WHEREAS, on Friday, December 11, 2015, Lawrence W. "Larry" Millard, a volunteer firefighter with the Endeavor Moundville Fire Department in Endeavor, Wisconsin, died in the line of duty in a tragic accident; and

WHEREAS, Lawrence W. "Larry" Millard had faithfully served his community as a volunteer firefighter for 34 years; and


WHEREAS, Lawrence W. "Larry" Millard leaves behind an honorable legacy of public service, and the people of Wisconsin mourn his death; and

WHEREAS, a funeral service will be held for Lawrence W. "Larry" Millard on Sunday, December 20, 2015;

NOW THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by federal and state law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags, beginning at sunrise on **Sunday, December 20, 2015**, and ending at sunset on that date.
