EXECUTIVE ORDER #25

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Firefighter Kyle R. Hayden of the Durand City/Rural Fire Department

WHEREAS, on May 13, 2019, Firefighter Kyle R. Hayden of the Durand City/Rural Fire Department died while returning home from taking his firefighter exam;

WHEREAS, Firefighter Kyle R. Hayden was a volunteer member of the Durand City/Rural Fire Department for 8 months;

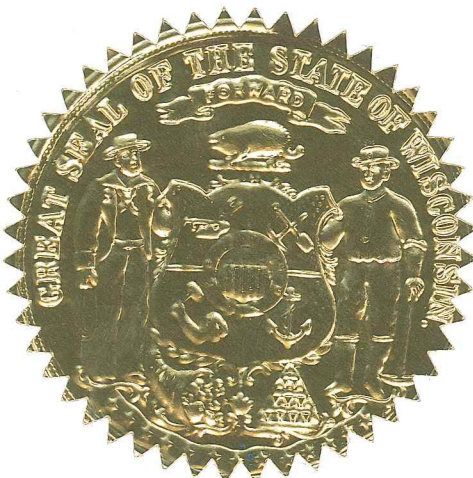
WHEREAS, Firefighter Kyle R. Hayden faithfully and honorably served the people of Durand and Wisconsin;

WHEREAS, Firefighter Kyle R. Hayden was a devoted husband, father, son, and brother, and a valued member of his community;


