



1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 332

May 1, 1997 - Introduced by Representatives JENSEN, FREESE, HUTCHISON, SKINDRUD, MUSSER, GARD, ALBERS, GOETSCH, WARD and SCHAFER, cosponsored by Senators HUELSMAN, SCHULTZ, FARROW and COWLES. Referred to Committee on Urban and Local Affairs.

1 **AN ACT to amend** 59.52 (6) (d) 1. of the statutes; **relating to:** the authority of a
2 county to construct golf courses.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a county board may construct, purchase, lease, develop, improve and operate facilities such as swimming pools, stadiums, parks, playgrounds, tennis courts and golf courses. Under this bill, a county may not construct new golf courses after the effective date of the bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 59.52 (6) (d) 1. of the statutes is amended to read:
4 59.52 (6) (d) 1. Construct, purchase, acquire, lease, develop, improve, extend,
5 equip, operate and maintain all county buildings, structures and facilities
6 hereinafter in this subsection referred to as "projects", including without limitation
7 swimming pools, stadiums, golf courses, tennis courts, parks, playgrounds, bathing

1 beaches, bathhouses and other recreational facilities, exhibition halls, convention
2 facilities, convention complexes, including indoor recreational facilities, dams in
3 county lands, garbage incinerators, courthouses, jails, schools, hospitals and
4 facilities for medical education use in conjunction with such hospitals, home for the
5 aged or indigent, regional projects, sewage disposal plants and systems, and
6 including all property, real and personal, pertinent or necessary for such purposes,
7 except that, after the effective date of this subdivision ... [revisor inserts date], a
8 board may not begin construction of a new golf course.
