1 **AN ACT to create** 15.497 (3) of the statutes; **relating to:** removing
2 reimbursement of expenses for members of the council on veterans programs.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, all members of councils created by statute are reimbursed for their actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties. The council on veterans programs is created by statute so the members of that council are eligible for reimbursement for their actual and necessary expenses in performing their duties as council members. This bill eliminates the reimbursement of members of the council on veterans programs for their actual and necessary expenses in performing their duties as council members.

3 **SECTION 1.** 15.497 (3) of the statutes is created to read:
