



1999 SENATE BILL 355

February 1, 2000 - Introduced by Senator ROBSON, cosponsored by Representative BLACK. Referred to Agriculture, Environmental Resources and Campaign Finance Reform.

1 **AN ACT** *to consolidate, renumber and amend* 289.645 (3) (intro.) and (a) of the
2 statutes; **relating to:** increasing the recycling fee imposed on the disposal of
3 solid waste.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law imposes a recycling fee of 30 cents per ton for solid waste, other than certain kinds of high-volume industrial waste, disposed of at a landfill or other waste disposal facility. This type of fee is often called a tipping fee. The recycling fee is deposited in the recycling fund.

This bill increases the recycling fee to \$2.00 per ton.
