1 **AN ACT relating to:** national guard tuition grants and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill increases the amount in the appropriation account that funds national guard tuition grants by \$1,800,000 for fiscal year 2002-03.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 **SECTION 1. Appropriation changes.**

3 (1) NATIONAL GUARD TUITION GRANTS. In the schedule under section 20.005 (3)
4 of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of military affairs under
5 section 20.465 (2) (a) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 2001, the dollar amount
6 is increased by \$1,800,000 for fiscal year 2002-03 for the purpose for which the
7 appropriation is made.
