



2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 950

March 11, 2004 – Introduced by Representatives HUBER, GOTTLIEB, ZIEGELBAUER, MUSSER, PLOUFF, ALBERS, J. LEHMAN, STONE, BERCEAU, CULLEN, WASSERMAN and MILLER, cosponsored by Senators ROESSLER, RISSER, KANAVAS, ROBSON, WIRCH and DECKER. Referred to Committee on Colleges and Universities.

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 36.53 of the statutes; **relating to:** authorizing a program for
2 tuition gift certificates at the University of Wisconsin System.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill authorizes the Board of Regents of the University of Wisconsin (UW) System to establish a program of gift certificates for the payment of tuition at the UW System. The individual named in a gift certificate may use the certificate to pay all or a portion of his or her tuition at any UW campus or for a UW study-abroad program. The gift certificate expires after two years and is not transferable except to a parent, child, spouse, or sibling.
