April 5, 2004 - Introduced by LAW REVISION COMMITTEE. Referred to Committee on Homeland Security, Veterans and Military Affairs and Government Reform.

AN ACT relating to: amending and revising under section 10.53 of the statutes 1 various provisions of sections 10.62 to 10.82 of the statutes for the purpose of correcting conflicts between the listings in sections 10.62 to 10.82 of the 3 statutes and the substantive statutes to which those sections refer (Revisor's Correction Bill).

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill confirms changes made by the revisor of statutes under section 10.53 of the statutes and included in the printed 2001-2002 Wisconsin Statutes. The individual changes made by this revisor's correction bill are explained in the Notes provided by the revisor of statutes in the body of the bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
