



## 2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 191

March 10, 2005 - Introduced by Representatives MOLEPSKE, GRONEMUS, KERKMAN, SEIDEL, STASKUNAS, HINES, ALBERS, BIES, LEHMAN, AINSWORTH, SHERIDAN, JESKEWITZ and OTT, cosponsored by Senators DECKER, ROESSLER, LASSA and DARLING. Referred to Committee on Education.

1     **AN ACT to amend** 120.11 (4) of the statutes; **relating to:** posting the proceedings  
2           of a school board meeting on the school district's Internet site.

*Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

Under current law, the proceedings of a school board meeting must be published in a newspaper published in the school district or publicized by school district-wide distribution. This bill allows a school board to post the proceedings on the school district's Internet site.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3           **SECTION 1.** 120.11 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:  
4           120.11 (4) The proceedings of a school board meeting shall be published within  
5           45 days after the meeting as a class 1 notice, under ch. 985, in a newspaper published  
6           in the school district, if any, ~~or~~ publicized by school district-wide distribution  
7           prepared and directed by the school board, or posted on the school district's Internet  
8           site, and paid out of school funds. If there is no newspaper published in the school

1 district, the proceedings shall be posted or published as the school board directs. For  
2 the purpose of publication, the proceedings shall include the substance of every  
3 official action taken by the school board at the meeting and a statement of receipts  
4 and expenditures in the aggregate. The school board shall make a detailed record  
5 of all receipts and expenditures available to the public for inspection at each school  
6 board meeting and upon request.
