



## 2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 350

April 22, 2005 – Introduced by Representatives WIECKERT, NISCHKE, JESKEWITZ, GRONEMUS, PETTIS, AINSWORTH, OTT, GUNDERSON, PETROWSKI, VOS, STONE, HINES, MUSSER and HAHN, cosponsored by Senators REYNOLDS, STEPP and BROWN. Referred to Committee on Colleges and Universities.

1     **AN ACT to amend** 36.11 (3) (c); and **to create** 38.12 (12) of the statutes; **relating**  
2           **to:** transfer of nursing course credits between the University of Wisconsin  
3           System and the Technical College System.

### *Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

Current law authorizes the Board of Regents of the University of Wisconsin (UW) System to establish policies for the appropriate transfer of credits: 1) between four-year UW System colleges; 2) between four-year and two-year UW System colleges; and 3) between the UW System colleges and colleges outside of the UW System.

This bill requires the Board of Regents of the UW System to work with technical college district boards to ensure that credits earned in UW System nursing courses are accepted for transfer by technical colleges. The bill also requires each technical college district board to work with the UW System to ensure that credits earned in technical college nursing courses are accepted for transfer by the UW System. The bill first applies in the academic year that begins at least 60 months following enactment.
