



2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 633

August 30, 2005 - Introduced by Representatives MUSSER, BOYLE, HAHN, PRIDEMORE, F. LASEE and TOWNSEND, cosponsored by Senator A. LASEE. Referred to Committee on Natural Resources.

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 29.173 (2) (b) and 29.193 (2) (cr) 1.; and *to create* 29.053 (4)
2 of the statutes; **relating to:** establishing a season for the hunting of deer while
3 using a muzzle-loading firearm.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Department of Natural Resources to establish an annual deer hunting season for the hunting of deer with a muzzle-loading firearm. Under the bill, the season must be held during the month of October, start on a Saturday, and last nine days.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 29.053 (4) of the statutes is created to read:
5 29.053 (4) Notwithstanding s. 29.014 (1), the department shall establish an
6 annual deer hunting season for the hunting of deer with a muzzle-loading firearm.
7 The season shall be held during the month of October, shall begin on a Saturday, and
8 shall be 9 days long.
