



## 2007 SENATE BILL 79

March 1, 2007 - Introduced by Senator LASSA, cosponsored by Representatives VRUWINK, ALBERS and GRONEMUS. Referred to Committee on Small Business, Emergency Preparedness, Workforce Development, Technical Colleges and Consumer Protection.

1     **AN ACT to create** 100.55 of the statutes; **relating to:** the sale and distribution  
2             of elastic yo-yos and providing a penalty.

*Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

This bill prohibits the sale or distribution of an elastic yo-yo, defined in the bill as any toy known as a “yo-yo waterball” or any other similar toy consisting of a rubber-like object that is attached to an elastic cord.

Because this bill creates a new crime or revises a penalty for an existing crime, the Joint Review Committee on Criminal Penalties may be requested to prepare a report concerning the proposed penalty and the costs or savings that are likely to result if the bill is enacted.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3             **SECTION 1.** 100.55 of the statutes is created to read:

4             **100.55 Sale and distribution of elastic yo-yos prohibited.** (1) In this  
5     section, “elastic yo-yo” means any toy known as a “yo-yo waterball” or any similar  
6     toy consisting of a rubber-like object that is attached to an elastic cord.

7             **(2)** No person may sell or distribute an elastic yo-yo to a person in this state.
