



2009 SENATE BILL 597

March 8, 2010 – Introduced by Senator HANSEN, cosponsored by Representative NELSON. Referred to Committee on Transportation, Tourism, Forestry, and Natural Resources.

1 **AN ACT relating to:** a grant for a highway project in the town of Pound.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

A provision of 2007 Wisconsin Act 20 (the biennial budget act) required the Department of Transportation (DOT) to award a \$500,000 grant in the 2007–09 fiscal biennium, from DOT's Transportation Facilities Economic Assistance and Development Program, to the town of Pound in Marinette County for the extension of N. 19th Road to W. 16th Road.

This bill allows the town of Pound to use this grant for any suitable local highway project.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
