1 **Relating to:** encouraging the purchase and use of American goods and services with
2 federal economic renewal grants.

3 Whereas, the economic downturn is having a critical impact on everyday
4 Americans who are struggling to maintain or find jobs in an increasingly difficult
5 environment; and

6 Whereas, those same Americans are the taxpayers that provide the revenue
7 needed to operate essential government services; and

8 Whereas, Congress has approved and President Obama has signed into law a
9 taxpayer-sponsored economic recovery package that will provide billions of dollars
10 to help economically devastated cities and states immediately provide jobs to millions
11 of out-of-work Americans through considerable infrastructure rebuilding, green
12 energy projects, and other projects that will require manufactured components; and

13 Whereas, our taxpayer dollars should be spent to maximize the creation of
14 American jobs restoring the economic vitality of our communities; and
