1 **AN ACT** *to create* 301.28 (3) of the statutes; **relating to:** training for newly hired
2 correctional officers.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Department of Corrections to ensure that each newly hired correctional officer receives at least four weeks of on-the-job training.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 301.28 (3) of the statutes is created to read:

4 301.28 (3) The department shall ensure that each newly hired correctional

6 correctional officer.
