



## 2015 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 106

February 4, 2016 – Introduced by Representatives BARCA, OHNSTAD, KERKMAN, JORGENSEN, BERCEAU, SPREITZER, SINICKI and WACHS, cosponsored by Senators WIRCH, WANGGAARD, VINEHOUT, NASS, COWLES and L. TAYLOR. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1     **Relating to:** recognizing the Kenosha Area Chamber of Commerce for 100 years of  
2           excellent service and dedication to the greater Kenosha area.

3           Whereas, the City of Kenosha has made historical contributions to the  
4     Wisconsin manufacturing industry and other key businesses by way of its unique  
5     geography and functionality as a key Great Lakes port in the 1800s; and

6           Whereas, the Kenosha Area Chamber of Commerce was established in 1916 as  
7     a business and community resource organization with a mission to serve and  
8     strengthen the Kenosha area by highlighting the area’s rich history of commerce and  
9     manufacturing; and

10          Whereas, since the early 1900s, Kenosha has served as home to such innovative  
11     companies as Snap-on Inc., Jockey, and American Brass, as well as revolutionary  
12     automobile companies, including Jeffery, Rambler, Nash, and American Motors  
13     Corporation, which have made such significant contributions to the automobile  
14     industry as the steering wheel and mass production techniques; and
