2015 SENATE BILL 337

October 15, 2015 – Introduced by Senators LASEE, MOULTON, STROEBEL and VUKMIR, cosponsored by Representatives NEYLON, BERNIER, MURPHY, T. LARSON, BRANDTJEN and GANNON. Referred to Committee on Elections and Local Government.

1 **AN ACT to amend** 121.91 (4) (o) 1. of the statutes; **relating to:** the school district
2 revenue limit adjustment for energy efficiency projects.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill limits the school district revenue limit adjustment for projects to implement energy efficiency measures or to purchase energy efficiency products (energy efficiency projects) to school districts that adopted a resolution before the effective date of the bill.

Current law generally limits the total amount of revenue per pupil a school district may receive from general school aids and property taxes in a school year to the amount of revenue received per pupil in the previous school year. However, there are several exceptions to the revenue limit under current law. Once such exception is for a school district that adopts a resolution to initiate an energy efficiency project. Under current law, a school district's revenue limit is increased by the amount the school district spends on the energy efficiency project in a school year, including amounts spent for debt service on a bond, note, or state trust fund loan used to finance the energy efficiency project. This bill limits this school district revenue limit adjustment to school districts that adopted a resolution to initiate an energy efficiency project before the effective date of the bill.
