



2015 SENATE BILL 738

February 11, 2016 - Introduced by Senators LASSA, L. TAYLOR, HARRIS DODD and MILLER, cosponsored by Representatives MILROY, BERCEAU, SUBECK, SHANKLAND, OHNSTAD, KESSLER, ZEPNICK, BOWEN and KAHL. Referred to Committee on Workforce Development, Public Works, and Military Affairs.

1 **AN ACT relating to:** increasing the funding for employment opportunity
2 demonstration projects and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill increases the funding during the 2015-17 biennium to supplement, on a one-to-one matching basis, federal employment opportunity demonstration project funds and funds from other federal and private foundation sources for job creation and development for individuals with low incomes.

3 **SECTION 1. Fiscal changes.**

4 (1) **EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY DEMONSTRATION PROJECT FUNDING.** In the schedule

2 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of workforce
3 development under section 20.445 (1) (cr) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of
4 2015, the dollar amount for fiscal year 2016-17 is increased by \$299,400 for the
5 purposes for which the appropriation is made.
