2 veterans, families, the nation, the state, and their communities and
3 commending the Legion on the occasion of its century of service.

4 Whereas, The American Legion began with a meeting of World War I veterans
5 held in Paris, France, in the spring of 1919; and

6 Whereas, The American Legion was chartered by Congress on September 16,
7 1919, and continues to be the largest veterans service organization in the nation with
8 over 1,800,000 members. The American Legion, Department of Wisconsin, has over
9 50,000 members and over 500 local posts; and

10 Whereas, The American Legion is responsible for the original GI Bill and has
11 a proud history of fighting for legislation to improve the lives of our nation's veterans;

13 Whereas, The American Legion provides programming to the youth of our
14 nation. American Legion Baseball is a local and national program that develops the
15 teamwork and leadership skills of youth; and
