



2021 SENATE BILL 1025

February 23, 2022 - Introduced by Senators TESTIN, NASS and BALLWEG, cosponsored by Representatives GUNDRUM, MAGNAFICI, CABRAL-GUEVARA, DITTRICH, MOSES, ARMSTRONG and HORLACHER. Referred to Committee on Health.

1 **AN ACT relating to:** location of deaths from COVID-19.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Department of Health Services to collect and report to the legislature the living situation location of all deaths from COVID-19 by June 30, 2022.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 **SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions.**

3 (1) REPORTING LOCATION OF COVID-19 DEATHS.

4 (a) In this subsection, "COVID-19" means the infection caused by the
5 SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus, including any viral variant derived from SARS-CoV-2
6 coronavirus.

7 (b) By June 30, 2022, the department of health services shall collect the living
8 situation location of all deaths from COVID-19 and shall report to the legislature

2 manner that ensures the anonymity of deceased individuals.
