## 2023 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 125

February 16, 2024 - Introduced by Representatives MURSAU, GUNDRUM, RATCLIFF  
and WITKE, cosponsored by Senator JAMES. Referred to Committee on Rules.

- 1     **Relating to:** proclaiming April 26, 2024, as Shared Parenting Day in Wisconsin.
- 2             Whereas, the State of Wisconsin recognizes that our children are our greatest  
3     resource; and
- 4             Whereas, our children need emotional and parental support from both parents  
5     to be as successful as possible; and
- 6             Whereas, separated parents who choose to share parenting duties significantly  
7     decrease the chances of undesirable youth troubles and struggles; and
- 8             Whereas, shared parenting is shown to have a significantly positive effect on  
9     children's well-being; and
- 10            Whereas, Wisconsin is currently the leading state in shared parenting  
11     outcomes for children with separated parents; and
- 12            Whereas, increasing the public awareness of the importance of providing  
13     children with the parental support they need from both parents benefits Wisconsin's  
14     children, their parents, and all of Wisconsin's citizens; now, therefore, be it
