AN ACT to authorize school district No. one in Dane County to lay an additional tax for building a School House.

§ 1. Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin.

That it shall and may be lawful for the trustees of May levy tax not to exceed school district No. one in the county of Dane to levy an one per cent. additional tax to the Tax now allowed by law not to exceed one per cent on the assessment roll of said district

for the purpose of erecting a school house in said district. § 2. The said tax shall be collected and returned in

To be levied by a vote.

How collected the same manner that is now provided by law for the collection of the tax for building school houses, Provided, that a majority of the legal voters in said school district who may be present at any school meeting of the district called by the Trustees of the district whose duty it shall be to give not less than ten days notice thereof in one of the newspapers printed in Madison stating the object to such meeting; shall vote in favor of levying the tax authorized by this act.

AN ACT to amend certain acts relative to the counties of Dodge and Washington.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin :
