of the result of such election and publish the same in the Result. newspaper printed in said village; the clerk of said election shall preserve the poll book and certificate of pro-Poll book. ceedings of said election and if said act is approved of by a majority he shall deliver the same to the clerk of the corporation when he shall be elected and said certificate shall be sufficient and conclusive evidence that this act has been adopted by a majority of the voters in accordance By majority of with the provisions of this section. If there shall be a voters. majority of "Noes" this act shall be null and void.

§ 34. This act shall be considered a public act and may When to take be altered, amended or repealed by any future legislature, effect. and shall take effect from and after its passage.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled "An act to incorporate the Trustees of the village of Mineral Point," approved January 11th, 1844.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

§ 1. That the assessment roll required by the 22nd To amend. section of the act of which this is amendatory to, be made by the assessors, and to be certified by at least two of them, shall be made out by the one assessor required by One assessor said act to be elected and shall be certified by him in-only certify. stead of being made out and certified as required by the said 22nd section.

AN ACT to authorize James Campbell and Thomas Stewart to build and maintain a dam on the Sugar River.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

§ 1. That James Campbell and Thomas Stewart, their successors and assigns, be, and they are hereby authorized to build and maintain a dam across the Sugar River,
