

AN ACT to authorize the Commissioners of Highways for the towns of Genessee and Mukwanago to lay out and alter a Territorial Road therein named.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin.

SECTION 1. That the commissioners of highways, for the town of Genessee, county of Milwaukee, W. T., be and they are hereby authorized to lay out a road agreeable to the provisions of "An act to provide for laying out and opening territorial roads, and for other purposes," passed January 11th, 1840, beginning in the territorial road leading through said town of Genessee to Milwaukee, at or near the quarter stake between sections 29 and 32, thence running on the section line between section twenty-nine and thirty-two, and section twenty-eight and thirty-three, until it intersects the said territorial road at or near the quarter stake between section twenty-eight and thirty-three. Commissioners of highways to lay out road.

SEC. 2. That so much of the present road as lies between the two points of intersection or runs catering through section twenty-eight and twenty-nine, is hereby vacated: *Provided, however,* said road shall not be vacated until the said commissioners shall have cleared the road hereby authorized as wide as the road so vacated. Proviso.

SEC. 3. That the commissioners of highways, in the town of Mukwanago, are hereby appointed commissioners to vacate or alter that part of the territorial road in the town of Mukwanago, commencing at or near the twenty-three mile stake in the territorial road running from Milwaukee to Janesville, and terminating where the territorial road leading to Fort Atkinson crosses the west line of the east half of the south east quarter of section thirty, town five, range eighteen. Commissioners of highways to alter or vacate road.
