

JOINT RESOLUTION relative to procuring a
sett of standard weights and measures.

RESOLVED by the Council and House of Representatives of
the Territory of Wisconsin:

That the Treasurer of the Territory be authorized and directed
to procure a sett of standard weights and measures, such as were
in legal use in the State of New York on the fourth day of July,
1839, and cause the same to be duly sealed by the Secretary of
State of New York aforesaid, and kept at the office of said Treas-
urer for the use of the Territory: *Provided*, That the cost of
procuring such weights and measures, so sealed, shall not exceed
the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars.

RESOLUTION requiring the Secretary of the Ter-
ritory to redeem certain bonds and scrip in the
hands of the Treasurer of the Territory.

RESOLVED, by the Council and House of Representatives of the
Territory of Wisconsin:

That the Treasurer of the Territory be and is hereby request-
ed to present to the Secretary of the Territory for payment all
scrip, bonds or other evidences of debt in his hands, or which
may hereafter come into his hands, which the said Secretary is
authorized to pay under and by the direction of the Secretary of
the Treasury of the United States.
