taxes unto the treasurer of the county of Crawford as heretofore required, but in lieu thereof said counties shall severally pay unto the treasurer of the county of Crawford, all costs, charges, fees and expenses, that shall be paid by the county of Crawford that may accrue in consequence of any prosecution, conviction, imprisonment, or proceedings whatever, against any person charged with any crime or misdemeanor, whether by statute or at common law within their respective counties, and the same shall remain a legal charge, claim and demand against the county in which the said crime or misdemeanor shall be charged to have been committed until paid unto the treasurer of the county of Crawford, and the said county of Crawford or the county commissioners thereof may sue and collect the same from such county in any court of competent jurisdiction.

May sue for.

SEC. 2. The provisions of this act shall extend to all such crimes and misdemeanors, and the costs, charges, fees and expenses that may hereafter accrue thereon that heretofore may have been committed in either of said counties since the same shall have been organized.

**AN ACT** to repeal an act entitled "an act to incorporate the Wisconsin Marine and Fire Insurance Company," approved February 28, 1839.

BE IT ENACTED by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

SECTION 1. That an act entitled "an act to incorporate the Wisconsin Marine and Fire Insurance Company," approved February 28, 1839, be and the same is hereby repealed.
