

**SEC. 3.** The said dam shall be subject to all the provisions of an act of the legislature of this Territory entitled "an act in relation to mills and mill dams," approved 13th January, 1840.

**SEC. 4.** The legislature, may at any time amend, alter or repeal this act.

**SEC. 5.** This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

**AN ACT** to vacate certain streets in the village of Geneva.

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

**SECTION 1.** That Pike street and Illinois street in the village of Geneva, be, and the same are hereby vacated and discontinued.

**AN ACT** to legalize the acts of the officers therein named.

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

**SECTION 1.** That the special election held in the county of Portage for county commissioners, and clerk, on the 25th day of March, 1845, shall be as valid as if the proper notice had been

given for said election, and that the official acts of the officers then elected are hereby declared to be to all intents and purposes, of the same force and validity, as if the legal notice for said election had been given.

**AN ACT to pay to the county of Iowa the sum therein named.**

BE IT ENACTED by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

SECTION 1. There shall be paid to the county of Iowa out of any moneys in the treasury of the Territory, the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars, being the amount of an appropriation heretofore made to John F. O'Neil by the second section of an act entitled "an act to provide for the payment of the expenses of the Legislative Assembly therein named," approved February 19, 1841, which said appropriation was assigned by said John F. O'Neil to the county of Iowa. *Provided*, that before the sum appropriated by this act shall be paid by the treasurer, or any warrant issued therefor by the auditor, a written relinquishment by the said John F. O'Neil of the said appropriation formerly made to him, or his assignment of the claim to the county of Iowa, shall be filed in the auditor's office, and the auditor shall also be satisfied that the sum appropriated to the said O'Neil has not been paid, before any warrant shall issue, or payment be made by virtue of this act.
