

AN ACT

To provide for levying a tax on Waterville joint school district, in the county of Waukesha.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin :

SECTION 1. That the trustees of Waterville joint school district, in the county of Waukesha, composed of sections numbers thirty-five and thirty-six, of the town of Summit, sections numbers thirty-one and thirty-two, in the town of Delafield, and the north half of sections numbers eleven and twelve, the north east quarter of section number ten, the east half of section number three, the whole of sections numbers one and two, in the town of Ottawa, in said county, be, and they are hereby authorized to levy a tax upon all the taxable property in said school district, not exceeding the sum of three hundred dollars, for the purpose of building a school house in said school district, and such other things as are connected therewith, and that said tax be collected and accounted for in the same manner as other school district taxes: *Provided*, that the legal voters of said district vote to raise said tax in the manner now provided for by law.
