

tory, shall be performed by the clerks of the district court, or of such court as may hereafter be established in lieu thereof, and the memorandum therein mentioned shall be filed with said clerks.

When members may withdraw from corporation.

SEC. 2. That any member of said corporation may at any time withdraw from the same, upon payment of his full proportion of all losses and expenses, and upon such further terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the board of directors.

Number of directors, and how elected.

SEC. 3. That after the next annual election the board of directors of said company shall consist of nine members, three of whom shall be elected for one year, three for two years, and three for three years; and annually thereafter three directors shall be elected for the term of three years.

AN ACT

To revive an act entitled "An act to authorize school district No. 1, in Platteville school district, to build a school house," approved January 31, 1846.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

Act revived.

SECTION 1. That the act entitled "An act to authorize school district number one, in Platteville school district, to

build a school house," approved January 31, 1846, be and the same is hereby revived to all intents and purposes.

SEC. 2. That the act which this act is intended to revive, shall be amended and known as school district number one, in Platteville school town, Grant county.

AN ACT

To incorporate the Nashotah House.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

SECTION 1. That Jackson Kemper, James Loyd Breck, Name and style of the corporation. William Adams, Solomon Davis, Benjamin Akerly, John Johnston, and William Leach, trustees, and their associates, together with such persons as may hereafter be associated with them, be, and they are hereby created a body politic and corporate, with perpetual succession, by the name of "Nashotah House," of the Nashotah lakes, in the town of Summit, Waukesha county, for the purpose of erecting, maintaining, and conducting a college of learning and piety, and General powers. by that name shall be competent to contract and be contracted with, to sue and be sued, to answer and be answered unto, in all courts of law and equity; acquire, hold, possess, enjoy, sell, convey, and dispose of, property, both real and personal, provided the annual income of said property shall not exceed,
