be admitted in evidence in the same manner as the original records.

Compensation

SEC. 6. Each of said persons so appointed shall be paid out of the treasury of the county of Waukesha for performing the duties of his appointment, such sum as shall have been agreed to be paid by said board, and by him to be received; but no extra compensation shall be allowed or agreed to be paid by said board.

Bonds may

SEC. 7. Said board may require either or both of said persons respectively so appointed to enter into bonds to said county of Waukesha, with one or more surelies to be approved by said board, conditioned for the faithful performance of the duties of their respective appointments.

AN ACT

Granting to A. L. Gregoire and George W. Jones, the right to keep and maintain a ferry across the Mississippi river.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

Forry to be constructed.

Section 1. That A. L. Gregoire and George W. Jones, their heirs, executors, and administrators, or assigns, shall have the exclusive right and privilege, for the period of fifteen years,

of keeping and maintaining a ferry across the Mississippi river, from the east bank of said river to the west bank of the said Mississippi river, on section thirty-two, in township number one, north of range number two west, commonly known as Boat Yard Hollow.

- SEC. 2. And the said ferry shall be subject to such regula-Subject to tions as other ferries are, or may by law be subject, fixing the certain prerates of toll, and the manner in which licensed ferries shall be kept and attended to; and no ferry shall be licensed within two miles of the point where the ferry above provided for shall be established.
- SEC. 3. This act may be amended or repealed by any future legislature of the territory, or future state of Wisconsin.
