SEC. 3. All laws and parts of laws contravening the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed.

Chap 32. An Act to authorize School District number seven in the town of Hustisford, Dodge county, to levy a tax to build a School House.

THE People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Authorized to levy tax.

Section 1. It shall and may be lawful for the trustees of school district number seven in the town of Hustisford, Dodge county, to levy a tax upon the real and personal property liable to taxation within said district, to the amount of three hundred and fifty dollars, to build a school house: Provided, a majority of the legal voters of said district, present at a meeting called for that purpose, shall vote to levy such tax. And it shall be the duty of the clerk of said district, or some other person appointed for that purpose, to give at least five days notice of the meeting aforesaid, by serving a written notice upon each of the legal voters in said district, or if absent, by leaving a copy thereof at his usual place of residence.

SEC. 2. The said tax shall be levied, collected and returned in the same manner as is now provided by law, for the collection of

taxes for building school houses.

Chap 33. An Act to extend the time for collecting and paying over tax in the town of Windsor, Dane county.

THE People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate

and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Windsor.

SECTION 1. That time be and is hereby extended to the collector of the town of Windsor, in Dane county, until the fifteenth day of April next, to collect and pay over to the county treasurer the sum of ninety-eight dollars and seventy-five cents, which now remains uncollected of the state tax of said county.
