Joint Resolutions relative to a proposed amendment to the constitution of the United States, concerning the election of Senators in congress.

Chap. 5.

Whereas, It is more in accordance with our republican institutions to give to the people the power of electing all officers of government, as far as practicable: Therefore

Resolved, That our senators in congress be instructed, and our representatives requested to propose, in congress an amendment to the constitution of the United States, in such effect that the people, instead of the the legislatures of the several States, shall hereafter elect their senators in congress by general ticket.
