Chap 420

The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to Charles T. Wakeley, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of seven hundred and eighty-two dollars and fifty cents, in full for publishing laws passed at the present session of the legislature, in the Wisconsin Argus and Wisconsin Express, up to and including the fourteenth day of April.

An Act to provide for laying out a State Road therein named.

Chap 421

The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. That Sylvanus Wade, William R. Tallmadge, Amos Giltner, Isaac C. Loomis, and Ormond Coc, Commissioners. be and they are hereby appointed commissioners to lay out and establish a state road, commencing in the town of Calumet on the south side of the harbor, on the east shore of lake Winnebago, in section 27, and running thence in an easterly direction to the north-east quarter of section 26 in the same town and range, and thence by the way of Green Bush in the county of Sheboygan, to Port Washington in the county of Washington.

SEC. 2. Said commissioners shall be entitled to such compensation for laying out said road as the boards of supervisors of the several counties through which said road may pass, may deem sufficient: *Provided*, That no money shall be paid out of the state treasury therefor: *And provided*, That any three of said commissioners shall form a quorum for business. Compensation.

Chap 422 An Act to detach town 16, range 19, from the towns of Forrest and Calumet and to form the town of Kossuth

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Town organized. SECTION 1. That town 16, north of range 19, east, be and is hereby detached from the towns of Calumet and Forrest, and that the same be constituted a separate town, to be known as the town of Kossuth.

First meeting. SEC. 2. The first town meeting of the inhabitants of said town, shall be held at the house of George Harkness.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

Chap 423 An Act to vacate portions of North Madison Road in the towns of Lisbon and Menomonee in Waukesha County

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Road discontinued. SECTION 1. That so much of the old territorial road, known as the North Madison road, in the towns of Lisbon and Menomonee, and not used by the Milwaukee and Lisbon plank road company, and which is thereby rendered unnecessary for travel as a public highway, be and the same is hereby discontinued.
