

execution, his, her or their counsel or attorney. When the said damages and costs, or costs only, are collected and paid over as herein directed, the said clerk shall enter satisfaction of said execution on the execution docket in his office. Clerk to send copy of tax bill of costs with execution.

§ 3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.

## Chap. 53.

*AN ACT to appropriate certain sums of money to the Wisconsin Institution for the Education of the Blind.*

Published, April 13, 1854.

*The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

§ 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Wisconsin Institution for the Education of the Blind, the sum of three thousand five hundred dollars for the support of said Institute during the current year. Appropriation.

§ 2. There is hereby appropriated to the said institution the further sum of twelve thousand dollars, for the construction of the certain main building of the Institution according to the plan of the same, one half of which shall be paid the present year, the remaining half in the year 1855, out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated. Further appropriations.

§ 3. Before the receipt of the respective sums of money appropriated by this act, the board of trustees of said Institute shall from time to time execute such bonds, and with such sureties as the Governor may require and approve, conditioned for the faithful application of such moneys to the object specified in this act. Board of trustees to give bonds, &c.

§ 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
