

**Chapter 88.**[*Published April 26.*]

An Act to appropriate to John Taylor the sum of money therein named, for digging a well for the States Prison.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The commissioner of the states prison is here- Appropriation-  
by authorized and directed to allow John Taylor three hundred and twenty-five dollars, including the amount already paid for such well by the commissioner of the state prison, the same being allowed two hundred dollars, (for all compensation for digging a well for the states prison in 1854,) on settlement with the said John Taylor for digging such well, and all other accounts between said John Taylor and said commissioner, and to ascertain and pay the balance (if any) to said John Taylor, out of any moneys appropriated to said commissioner to defray the expenses of the states prison.

SEC. 2. This act shall be in force from and after its passage.

**Chapter 89.**[*Published April 24.*]

An Act to amend Chapter 126 of the Revised Statutes relating to Information in the nature of a Quo Warranto.

*The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SEC. 1. Informations in the nature of a Quo Warranto Quo Warranto  
may be filed and prosecuted in the circuit courts of this --information
