

CHAPTER 61.

Published May 12.

An Act to change the name of George R. Rockwell and Martha H. Percel to those of George R. Nulph and Martha H. Nulph.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Names changed. SECTION 1. The names of George R. Rockwell and Martha H. Percel of the town of New Buffalo, in the county of Sauk, are hereby changed to those of George R. Nulph and Martha H. Nulph, and by that last mentioned names they shall hereafter be known and recognized.

Made heirs, &c. SEC. 2. The said George R. Nulph and Martha H. Nulph shall be known as the adopted son and daughter, and heirs-at-law of Moses Nulph and his wife, of said town of New Buffalo, Sauk county, and mutually entitled to all the rights and privileges, and subject to all the duties of inheritance, support and maintenance, as fully and effectually, and in the same manner as they might or should be if they were the legitimate children of Moses Nulph and his wife.

Take effect. SEC. 3. This act shall take effect as soon after its passage as the said Moses Nulph and wife shall file in the office of the county judge of the county of Sauk, their written consent to the provisions of this act.

CHAPTER 62.

An Act to change the name of Frederick Delmot Gregory to Frederick Johnson.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Name changed SECTION 1. The name of Frederick Delmot Gregory is hereby changed to Frederick Johnson, by which name

the said person shall be called and known to all legal intents and purposes.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 63.

An Act to change the name of Isabella Mary Maynard to Isabella Mary Rollin, and that the same may be made the heir-at-law of Thomas H. Rollin.

The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. That the name of Isabella Mary Maynard, ^{Name changed} of the village of Berlin, in the county of Marquette, in said state, be and the same is hereby changed to Isabella Mary Rollin, by which name the same individual shall and may hereafter be known in all places whatever.

SEC. 2. And that the said Isabella Mary Rollin be and ^{Heir-at-law.} is hereby made and constituted heir at law of and to the said Thomas H. Rollin.

CHAPTER 64.

An Act to change the name of Philipp Albert to Phillip Hess, and make him heir-at-law of John Hess.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The name of Philipp Albert, of the city of ^{Name changed} Milwaukee, and county of Milwaukee, is hereby changed to Phillip Hess, and by that name he shall be hereafter known and recognized in law for all purposes whatever.
