AN ACT establishing the name and heirship of Mary Conger.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

§ 1. The name of Mary Conger, infant daughter of Anna Conger, is hereby changed to Mary Anne Torrey, by which name she shall be hereafter known and recognized. Name and heirship of Mary Conger established.

§ 2. The said Mary Anne Torrey shall be esteemed and taken to be the heir-at-law of Wilson Torrey and Urania Torrey his wife, of Fox Lake, in the county of Dodge, and the mutual obligations of parent and child shall exist and pertain as fully between the said Wilson Torrey and Urania Torrey, and the said Mary Anne Torrey, as in the case of mutual parentage.

§ 3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled "An Act to provide for more fully carrying into effect the general Banking Law of this State." Approved March 18, 1856.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

§ 1. An act entitled "An act to provide for more fully carrying into effect the General Banking Law of this State," approved March 18, 1856, is hereby amended by striking out the words "six hundred" where they occur in the first and second sections of said act, Salary of Clerk increased.
