AN ACT to amend Chapter seven of the Revised Statutes.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Certificate in case of election of U. S. Senator,

§ 1. In case the President of the Senate and Speaker of the Assembly, or either of them, shall neglect or refuse to execute the certificate required by Section ten of Chapter seven of the Revised Statutes, the Chiet Clerks of the Senate and Assembly shall make out a certified statement of the result of such election, stating the whole number of votes given and the number of votes received by each person voted for, and shall deliver such certified statement to the Governor, and a certified copy thereof to the Secretary of State.

Duty of Gover-

- § 2. The Governor shall, upon receiving such certified statement, make out and deliver to the person who shall have received a majority of the votes cast a certificate under the seal of the State, signed by him as Governor, certifying that such person has been duly elected Senator.
- § 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
