Published, July 16, 1857.

AN ACT to provide for auditing the accounts of the Revisers.

*The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

§ 1. The Secretary of State is hereby directed and authorized to audit the accounts of the persons appointed under the provisions of an act entitled "An Act to provide for a revision of the General Laws of the State of Wisconsin," approved October 13, 1856, for services performed under the provisions of said act from time to time, when presented by said Revisers upon the certificate of said Revisers, stating the number of days actual service rendered by each, and to draw warrants upon the State Treasurer for the amounts audited, and a sufficient sum of money is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the State Treasury not otherwise appropriated to pay such warrants.

§ 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

AN ACT to change the fiscal year of the State of Wisconsin, and to amend an act relating to printing, approved April 19, 1852.

*The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

§ 1. Section thirty-one of Chapter nine of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended so that the fiscal year of this State shall hereafter commence on the first day of October in each year, and close on the thirtieth day of September next succeeding.
