

GENERAL LAWS

OF THE

STATE OF WISCONSIN.

Chapter 1.

Published January 20th, 1858.

AN ACT for the auditing and payment of the Postage of the Members and Officers of the Senate and Assembly and State Officers.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The Secretary of State is hereby authorized and required to audit the accounts for postage of the Members of the Legislature and Officers thereof, Executive Office, Office of Secretary of State, Attorney General, State Superintendent, State Treasurer, Clerk of the Supreme Court and Superintendent of Public Property; said accounts to be certified by the Postmaster at Madison, by affidavit. Secretary of State authorized to audit postage accounts.

SEC. 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Postmaster at Madison, out of any money in the State Treasury not otherwise appropriated, a sum sufficient for the payment of the above accounts, to be drawn from the treasury upon the presentation of said accounts properly certified. Money appropriated.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
