AN Act requiring the overseers of highways to give bonds.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

Overseers of highways to give bonds.

SECTION 1. Each overseer of highways shall, before he enters upon the duties of his office, execute to the board of supervisors of his town, if a majority of said board so require, a bond to be filed by the town clerk, in such amount as shall be required by said board of supervisors, conditioned for the faithful discharge of the duties of his office and the proper application and payment of all moneys that may come into his hands by virtue of said office as provided by law.

SEC. 2. This act to take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

AN Act to repeal section four of chapter seventy-seven of the laws of eighteen hundred and fifty-four, entitled "An act to provide for the contingent expenses of the Bank Comptroller's office."

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

Repealed.

SECTION 1. Section four of chapter seventy-seven of the laws of eighteen hundred and fifty-four, approved April first, eighteen hundred and fifty-four, is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
