AN ACT to authorize the Printing of the Report of the Joint Committee appointed to investigate into alleged frauds in the disposal of the Land Grants, and for other purposes.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The Joint Select Committee of the Legislature, appointed at the present session, to investigate into alleged frauds in the disposal of the lands granted to this State to aid in the construction of railroads by act of Congress, approved June 3d, 1856, and for other purposes, are hereby authorized to procure to be printed and stitched in pamphlet form, by the Public Printer, five thousand copies of their report and the accompanying evidence for the use of the Legislature, and to make such needful regulations in regard thereto as they may deem proper: *Provided*, That the Public Printer shall cause said report and evidence to be printed at the rate of at least sixty-four pages daily; that the matter thereof shall be set in solid unlead type, and without unnecessary blanks or spaces, and shall be completed and delivered on or before the eighth day of May next.

SEC. 2. The Secretary of State is hereby authorized and empowered to audit the account of the Public Printer for publishing said report: *Provided*, Said Printer shall furnish the same within the time specified, at a price to be agreed upon between such committee and the Public Printer, and not exceeding fifty cents per copy for the first three hundred pages, and fifteen cents per copy for each hundred pages above that number, of size and matter corresponding with the annual report as published by the State Printer, and in manner as above provided; and upon the completion and delivery of said work shall draw his warrant on the State Treasurer for the amount so audited and allowed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
