

the contrary, and it shall be the duty of the secretary of state, on receiving the aforesaid reports, to audit and allow the same.

SEC. 2. The provisions of this act shall apply to Application of the years 1856 and 1857, as fully as to the year 1858. this act.

SEC. 3. This act shall be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 13.

AN ACT To change the time of holding the terms of the circuit court in the county of Washington.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The next term of the circuit court of Washington county shall be held on the first Wednesday in April next, and thereafter the terms of the circuit court, for said county of Washington shall be held on the first Wednesday in April and the second Monday in October in each year. Courts—when held.

SEC. 2. All writs, recognizances and other proceedings, made returnable to the circuit court of said county of Washington, shall be deemed and considered returnable to the terms of said court, as fixed by this act; and all motions, continuances and other proceedings, noticed to be heard at any regular term of said court, shall be deemed and considered to be noticed for hearing at the regular terms of said court as the same are fixed by this act. Writs, &c., when returnable.

SEC. 3. So much of any act and all laws now in force, inconsistent with the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
