

as follows: Upon the completion and delivery of the entire ten thousand copies as before provided, upon the presentation of the receipt of the superintendent of public property that they are so delivered and accepted by the governor, attorney general, and state treasurer, the secretary of state shall audit the entire account for furnishing the statutes, in accordance with the contract price, and draw his warrant upon the state treasurer therefor.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 68.

AN ACT to amend section 17, chapter 10, of the revised statutes, entitled "of state officers."

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Sub-division 7, in section 17, of chapter 10 of the revised statutes, is hereby amended by adding to the end of said sub-division the words, "and shall also certify to the state treasurer the names of all judges, officers, or other persons whose salaries are provided for by permanent appropriation to be paid from the state treasury, specifying the office and the term for which they were elected or appointed, and in case of vacancy in any office aforesaid by removal, resignation or otherwise, he shall certify the same to the state treasurer, immediately upon receiving official information of the fact."

SEC. 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
