

CHAPTER 133.

[Published April 6, 1860.]

AN ACT to provide for the sale of lands returned to the county treasurer of the county of Chippewa, for the non-payment of taxes, for the year 1857.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. All lands returned to the county treasurer of the county of Chippewa for the non-payment of taxes for the year 1857, upon which the taxes, interest and charges shall not have been paid, at the time of giving the notice of sale, shall be sold by such treasurer on the third Monday of June next, and notice of the same shall be given, and all proceedings relative to such sale shall be had, as provided by law in cases of sale of lands for non-payment of taxes.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 134.

[Published March 23, 1860.]

AN ACT to change the time for holding elections in the city of Hudson.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The annual election in the said city of Hudson, for such city officers as are to be elected annually, shall be held on the first Tuesday of April in each year, instead of the first Monday as heretofore.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
