

CHAPTER 168.

[Published March 30, 1860.]

AN ACT relating to the duties of register of deeds.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Register to
provide books
for register-
ing.

SECTION 1. That each register of deeds in the several counties of this State shall provide separate books, in which he shall enter, as provided in section two of this act, all certified copies of sheriff's certificates of writs of attachment of real estate, and certificates of sale of real estate, and all notices of the pendency of any action affecting the title to real property, which are now, by law, required to be filed in the office of register of deeds.

Duty of regis-
ter.

SEC. 2. Every such register of deeds shall enter, in such book or books, to be by him kept for that purpose, the day, hour and minute when he receives any such certificate or certificates, or notice of the pendency of any such action; the names of the parties in such certificate or notice, designating who is the plaintiff and who the defendant; the names of the attorneys of the respective parties; the time when the land was attached, and the description thereof; and the description of the real estate sold upon execution, and the time of such sale; also the amount of indebtedness claimed in such notice.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
