

## CHAPTER 304.

[Published April 25, 1860.]

AN ACT to constitute Shawano [Shawanaw] county a part of the tenth judicial circuit, and to fix the terms of court therein.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

- Made part of 10th circuit.**      **SECTION 1.** The county of Shawano [Shawanaw] shall be and hereby is constituted a part of the tenth judicial circuit, and the terms of the circuit court shall be hereafter holden in said county, on the third Monday of February, and the second Monday of August, of each year.
- Terms of court.**      **SEC. 2.** There shall be no grand jury summoned or empannelled for the August term of the circuit court for said county of Shawano [Shawanaw], unless ordered by the judge of said tenth judicial circuit. When so ordered, said judge shall give fifteen days notice to the clerk of the circuit court of said county, and a grand jury shall be summoned and empannelled, as provided by law in other cases.
- No grand jury for August term, except ordered by judge on 15 days notice to clerk.**      **SEC. 3.** All writs, recognizances, and other proceedings made returnable [returnable] to the circuit court of said county of Shawano [Shawanaw], shall be deemed and considered returnable to the terms of said court, as fixed by this act.
- Return of processes.**      **SEC. 4.** So much of all acts, or parts of acts, contravening or conflicting with the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed.
- Repealing sec.**      **SEC. 5.** This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
- Effect.**      Approved March 31, 1860.
