

SEC. 4. The Prison Commissioner shall keep a record of such receipts, so given by him, and report the same with his annual report, and the Secretary of State shall file in his office the receipt presented to him. Prison com. to keep record of receipts.

SEC. 5. The Secretary of State is hereby authorized, in cases where he is satisfied that the State Prison Commissioner has certified the number of miles too large, to reduce the same so as to make it comply with the actual distance. Sec'y of state authorized to reduce distance charged.

SEC. 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 344.

AN ACT to amend section fifteen, of chapter 183, of the Revised Statutes, entitled "An act of offences cognizable before Justices of the Peace."

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section fifteen, of chapter 183, of the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended by adding the words "except Silver Lake, in Sheboygan county," after the word "state," and before the word "for," in the third line of said section fifteen, of chapter 183. Silver Lake, in Sheboygan Co. excepted.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
