CHAPTER 45.

AN ACT to amend chapter 164, of the General Laws of 1859, entitled "An act to provide for the drainage and reclamation of the swamp and overflowed lands in the counties of Calumet, Brown, Oconto, Kewaunee and Door."

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

to exclude Cal-
umet county.

SECTION 1. Chapter one hundred and sixty-four, of the General Laws of 1859, entitled "An act to provide for the drainage and reclamation of swamp and overflowed lands in the counties of Calumet, Brown, Oconto, Kewaunee and Door," is hereby amended by striking out the word "Calumet," wherever it occurs in the title and body of the said act, and by striking out the fifth subdivision of section one thereof.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 46.

AN ACT to extend the time for the collection of taxes in the town of Freedom, in the county of Outagamie.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The time for the collection of all taxes, except the State tax, in the town of Freedom, in the county of Outagamie, due for the year 1859, is hereby extended until the tenth day of May next; until which time the treasurer of said town, by virtue of his warrant for

the collection of taxes, shall have the same power and authority to receive and enforce the payment of taxes in his town, and shall proceed in the same manner as is prescribed [prescribed] by law.

SEC. 2. The said town treasurer shall, on the tenth day of May next, make returns to the county treasurer of said county, of all lands upon which taxes have not been paid, and the county treasurer shall proceed to sell the lands upon which the taxes remain unpaid, according to law. The town treas'r to make return's by May 10th.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 47.

AN ACT to amend chapter three, of the General Laws of 1859, entitled "An Act in relation to the publication of legal notices."

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. Chapter three, of the General Laws of 1859, entitled "An Act relating to the publication of legal notices," is hereby amended, as follows : by inserting, in section one, the words "commenced or" before the word "completed," where the same occurs in the eighth line of said section : also by inserting the word "commenced," after the word "be," where the same occurs in the ninth line of said section : also by inserting, after the word "ordered," where it occurs in said section one, the words "or commenced:" also by inserting after the word "ordered," where it occurs in section two, of said chapter three, the words "or commenced."

Sundry amendments to law of 1859, relating to publication of legal notices.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
