CHAPTER 87.

[Published March 10, 1860.]

AN ACT to amend section three, of chapter 116, of the Revised Statutes, entitled "Of Circuit courts."

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Amending sec
3, chap. 116,
R. S.

SECTION 1. Section three, of chapter one hundred sixteen, of the Revised Statutes of this State, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following words: "at any such term when so called, any and all actions, causes or motions, regularly noticed for trial or hearing, and all business which might or could be transacted at a stated or regular term of the court, may be entertained, tried and determined."

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 88.

[Published March 10, 1860.]

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and ninety-seven, of the Private and Local Laws of 1859, entitled "An act to incorporate the city of Buffalo."

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Sec. 1, chap. 1,
amended.

SECTION 1. Section first, of chapter first, of said act, is hereby amended by striking out the word "next," in the third line of said section, and inserting in its place the figures "1859."

Sec. 1, chap. 2,
amended.

SEC. 2. Section first, of chapter second, of said act, is hereby amended by striking out the words "in April," in the tenth line of said section.

SEC. 3. Section two, of chapter two, of said act, is hereby amended by striking out the words "and at every subsequent first Monday in June," in the 24th and 25th lines of said section, and inserting, in their stead, the words, "and on the day of the annual town meeting in each year thereafter." Sec. 2, chap. 2, amended.

SEC. 4. Section nine, of chapter two, of said act, is hereby amended by striking out the words "of April," in the 4th line of said section. Sec. 9, chap. 2, amended.

SEC. 5. Section twelve, of chapter ten, of said act, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: "The city of Buffalo city, at large, shall be represented, in the board of supervisors of the county of Buffalo, by one alderman of said city, acting as supervisor in said county board; which said supervisor shall be elected by the city council, and the alderman, so acting as supervisor, shall have power to substitute any other alderman to act as such supervisor in his stead." Sec. 12, chap. 10, amended.

SEC. 6. Section fourteen, of chapter ten, of said act, is hereby amended by striking out the words "and shall be quarter-yearly paid, by said treasurer, to the treasurer of Buffalo county," where they occur in the 16th, 17th and 18th lines of said section. Sec. 14, chap. 10, amended.

SEC. 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 89.

[Published March 12, 1860.]

AN ACT providing for additional terms of the circuit court for the county of Racine.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. In addition to the terms of the circuit court, now required by law, to be held for the county of Racine, there shall thereafter be held, in each year, terms of such circuit court for said county of Racine, commencing on the first Tuesday in February, and the first Tuesday in August; but no jury shall be summoned to attend such additional terms, unless the same be specially ordered by the circuit judge of the first circuit.
